

KINDERGARTEN DAILY SCHEDULE

Our Kindergarten focuses on teaching children to become confident, independent learners with strong personal values.

Utilizing an inquiry-based model gives children opportunities for differentiated learning, while being immersed in the German language.

Kindergarten is an exciting time for students, as they find and express their own unique voices while learning from their past experiences and exploring areas that interest them.

Morning Circle

Students start their day with greetings, introduction to themes and topics, calendar, yoga, and braingym.

Inquiry Time

Children are divided into groups and work in rotating learning areas, i.e., Reading & Writing, and inquiry time.

Free Play

Our classrooms invite children to explore in the art, dramatic play, reading corner, games, puzzles and scientific inquiry areas. During this time, teachers guide students in a variety of art and literature activities.

Outdoor Exploration

This time focuses on gross motor activities, language learning, fostering social interactions and personal growth.

Additional Core Programming

Our special weekly classes include: Second Step (English), Physical Education (English), Art (German), Science (German), and Music (English).

Lunch

Lunch presents children another opportunity to practice and improve language and social skills while eating a nutritious lunch.

Second Outdoor Exploration

Fresh air, exercise, and social interactions with Elementary students and their 5th grade buddies.

Story Time

During this time the teachers read stories aloud based on the monthly or weekly themes.

Quiet Time

This time encourages the children to calm their minds and bodies in order to process all they have learned and experienced.

Closing Circle

Just as we started the day as a group, we end each day as a group. During this time we revisit items from our themes, practice letter and number writing, phonetics, reading, vocabulary, and math exercises.
