We will work on a first draft; have a 'reading circle' where we read our work-in-progress. On Friday at 2:30 we will have a special presentation of our favorite works from the week.

The students will go through the process of creating their own play, or improvising costumes, of preparing the stage props and scenery, and of performing the play - with an audience of their choice. The greatest benefit from this course will be for school-age students who already master an acceptable level of the german language, but adjustmetns and alternative learning and participation opportunities will be offered to non-german speaking students. Knowledge of the German language is strongly recommended, but is not a must.
